



A Message from Father Rick

When Jesus embarked on his Mission, He had to wrestle against the most powerful religious institution of his time. He made it clear from the beginning that his purpose was not to abolish the teachings of the Law or to destroy the established institution, but rather to fulfill them. This would mean challenging his audience to go beyond the letter of the law. Jesus said, "I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." From now on it was no longer a matter of observing the law, but even more doing more than what the law required. It would mean not just loving ones' neighbors but even loving the enemies. It would mean not doing something evil, like adultery, stealing, or even killing but avoiding even the thoughts of doing them. The great thing about the radical words of Jesus is in the end he promised to send an advocate and guide – the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was no longer physically present, the Holy Spirit would take over and continue leading the disciples. May the Holy Spirit come upon us and enkindle in us the Fire of God's Merciful Love as we specially prepare ourselves for the season of Lent in a few days.
