



A Message from Father Rick

Our Gospel this second Sunday of Lent brings us to the top of a mountain. Traditionally the mountain has been referred to as Mount Tabor. Jesus transfigured before the eyes of the three disciples. For the first time they saw that there was more to Jesus than they knew him. Jesus' true glorious image as Lord was revealed to them. It must have been a magnificent sight to behold, which led Peter to suggest for them to stay on the mountain top a little bit longer by building tents. The beautiful experience could easily mislead the disciples away from the real reason why they were on the top of the mountain. Jesus brought them there to pray and to be in communion with the Father and when that assuring voice was heard Jesus appeared to be normal again. They all, however, had to come down and continue their journey to Jerusalem where the great trial awaited Jesus and the disciples. The same trial awaits all of us in every twist and turn of life's journey. Let us stand strong and courageous, Saint Paul reminds us; "Brothers and sisters: If God is for us, who can be against us?"


*A Celebration of Life
