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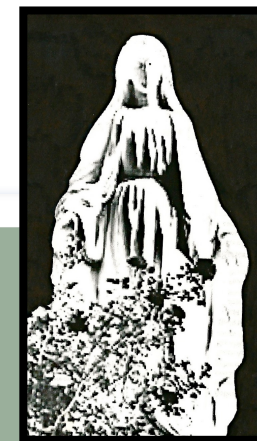
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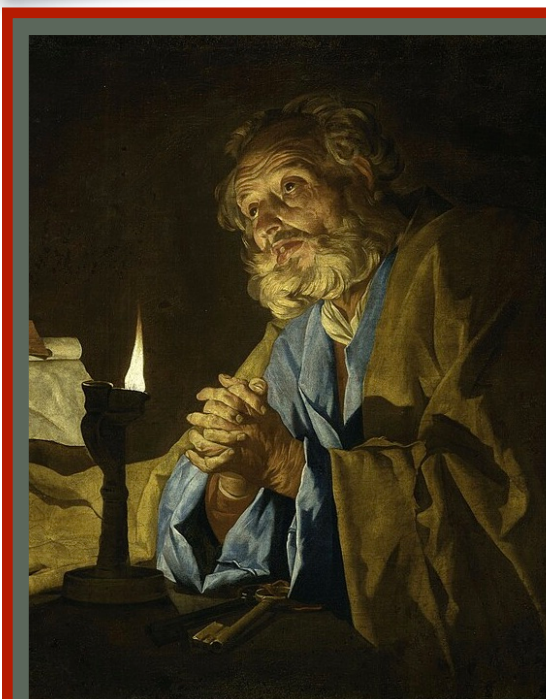

## A Message from Father Rick The Twelfth Sunday

The Gospel this week focuses on trusting in God's providence and overcoming fear in the face of adversity. Jesus has predicted that the disciples will face difficulties in their mission. Many people will not receive them well, even within the land of Israel. Even family members will turn away from the disciples because of the disciples' commitment to Jesus and the kingdom. Jesus might be understood as putting suffering in perspective. The Disciples of Jesus are called upon to keep their focus on God. Those who can harm the body do not have ultimate power; God does. Still persecution and suffering can not be avoided or prevented. But Jesus reassures his disciples that God knows and cares about what happens to his children.

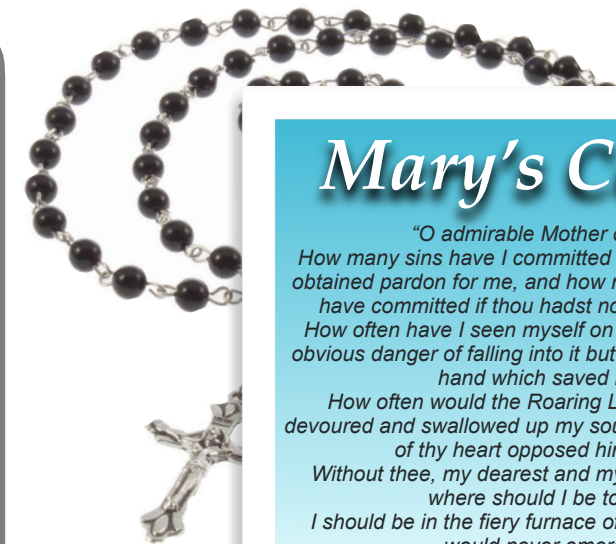
### \*A Big Thank You...
