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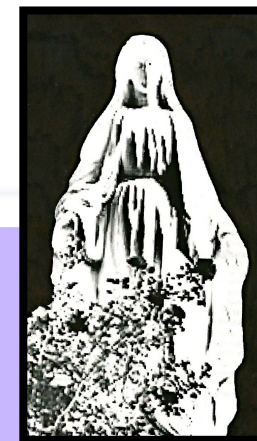
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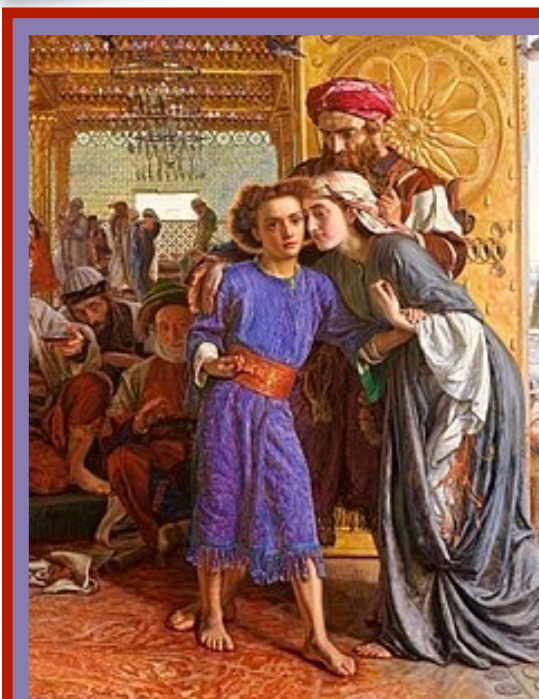

A Message from Father Rick



Discipleship means following the Lord and leaving home and family. It means a complete change of life's direction and purpose or a complete career change for some. Such decision usually involves a lot of risks and insecurities. That's why we read in the Gospel of St. Luke this Sunday that those who want to follow the Lord have their "ifs" and "buts." A life-time commitment, like priesthood or religious life does not come easy to most people. It takes a lot of conviction, but most of all Love and willingness suffer and sacrifice. The Lord, however, promises that those who follow and serve him will receive their rewards a hundred fold in this life and in the next. God's generosity is always without measure. The call of the Lord is open to all. He is calling to us to follow him in the ordinary walk of our life and perhaps in a life of service to the Church. Those who are called to marriage and family life are, nonetheless, called to serve the Lord through the various ministries in the church. This call to service is a form of response to the Lord's call of discipleship. Let us pray that we may be able to overcome our indecision and finally commit to the Lord whatever and whenever He is calling us.

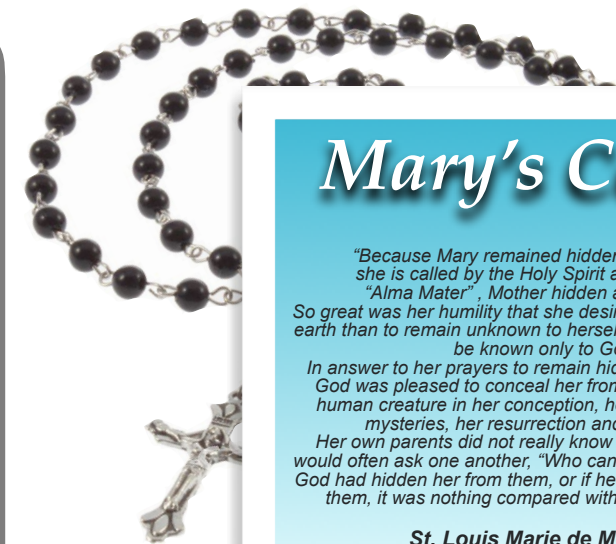
*Fathers Day Novena...Pops are now Tops!
