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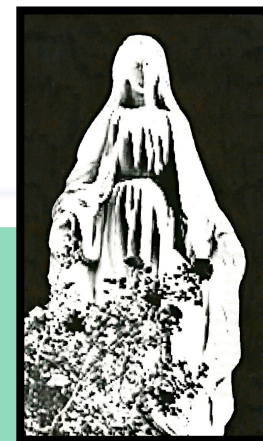
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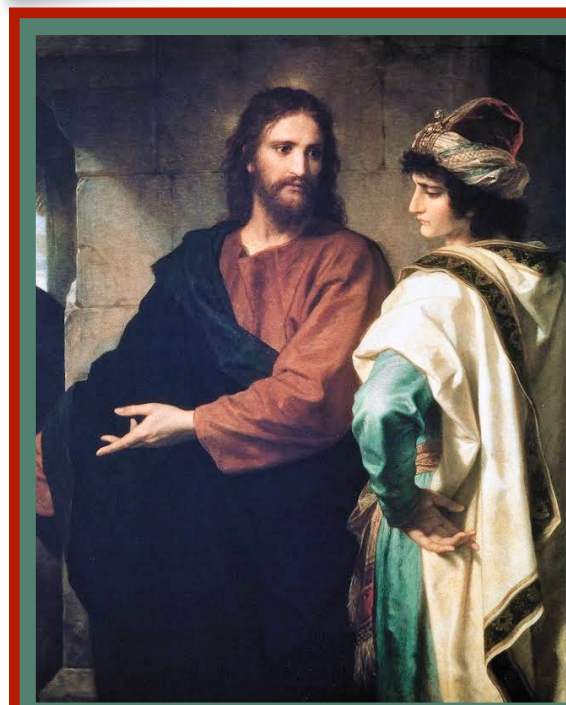

A Message from Father Rick

The last few lines in this Sunday Gospel, (Matthew 11:28-30), should remind us how concerned Jesus is with the wellbeing of His disciples. How comforting it is that we have Jesus who knows what we are going through in life, both physically and spiritually. The struggles and the burdens are always there and so he reminds us that it is only in Him and with Him that we can find rest and lighten our burdens. These words of Jesus are both invitation and promise. Because it is an invitation, we need to accept it and act on it. We need to find time to be with the Lord in Person, through His Real Presence among us, The Holy Eucharist and the Blessed Sacrament in Churches. We can encounter the Lord also as he promised, when we lift up our hearts and thoughts through prayer. When we pause, for example, for a moment in the midst of our busy day to day schedule. As a promise of Our Lord, we can put much hope that when things may seem unbearable, we have the grace to never give up. We persevere, following and carrying the cross. I earnestly invite you to come join us not just on Sundays but even one day on weekdays in our Eucharistic celebration where Jesus offers Himself as our nourishment.

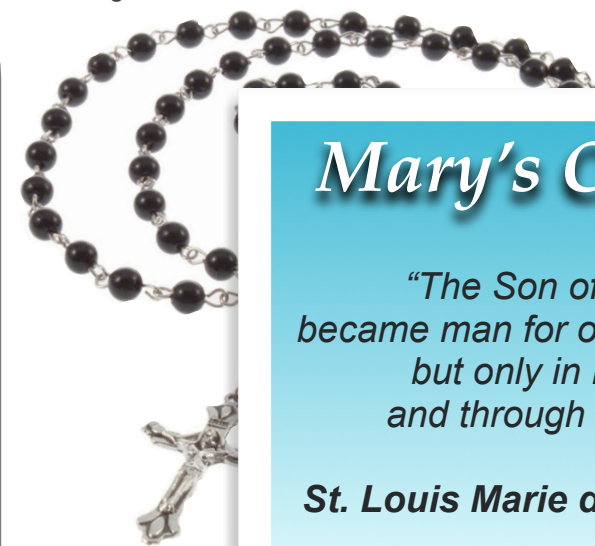
*Our Lady's Many Ministries...
