A Message from Father Rick



Back in High School I remembered, I did not bother whether or not I was able to go to mass. At some instance I even stopped going to church. Looking back, I ask myself, why? I grew up where going to the Church was an integral part of every Sunday. Whether one liked it or not, one had to go. Going to the church became a holy obligation to my parents and to the family. When I felt I could stand on my own, I was no longer obliged to do. Now I realize that going to the church should not become an obligation. It should not become a burden, but rather an act of love and gratitude. I go to the Church to pray or participate in the mass because I realize the importance of being connected to God and to His people. In this Sunday's gospel, Jesus reminds us that when we are in solidarity with His people, hungry for the Word of God, miracles do happen. When we are willing to let go and let God direct our lives, He brings fulfillment to our desires more than we can fill or satisfy ourselves. This is the miraculous multiplication of the Bread. No matter how little or small our provisions, when we surrender them to God, they will be multiplied. Today as we partake of the Eucharist, our holy communion with Jesus, may we truly become a gift and truly connect with Him and with our neighbors.

September 6- BBQ Day...all hands on deck.

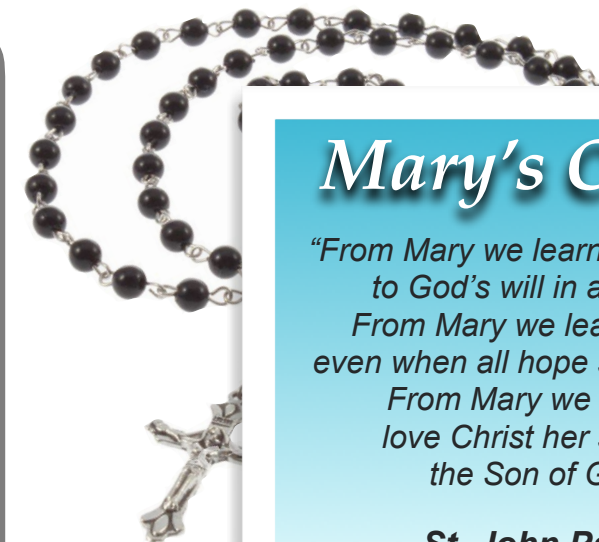
